

PSA minutes for May 4, 2009 meeting

Opening Prayer: Mr. Rooney opened the meeting with a prayer at 6:50 p.m.

Secretary's report: After members reviewed the minutes from the April meeting Tracy made a motion to accept the minutes and Robin seconded.

Treasurer's report: Noreen reported that we are in good shape, Bingo has picked up! Cherie made a motion to accept the treasurer's report and Ruth seconded.

Committee report's:

Sunshine: Nothing to report from April.

School Store: Nothing to report from April.

Social Committee: Ruth reported that the flyer about Family Get Moving night went home. The event will be held on 6/5, 6:30-8:30. Volunteers will be needed.

Middle School: The Middle School trips are coming up, sixth and seventh graders are going to Boston, The eighth graders are going to Camp Chingachook.

School Banking: Heidi reported that the 2nd newsletter was sent home. There is approximately \$300.00 being deposited monthly.

Spring Fundraiser:

Silent Auction: The approximate profit made from the event is \$16,000.00.

Golf Classic: Ruth reported that donations are coming in, there is a meeting planned for 5/5. The committee is offering a pre-pay discount. The price is \$100.00/ golfer. This years outing is again going to be held at Winding Brook.

Let's Appraise: Heidi reported that the event made a profit of \$1,659.85. There were approximately 102 people and 334 items appraised. Heidi and the committee are planning to do this event again next year.

Cookbook: The recipe deadline has been changed until the last day of school. The committee will

be working on the cookbook over the summer and will be available for purchase in the Fall.

KART/5K: Cherie, Robin and Annmarie would like a list of the names of people that chose to be on

this committee for the 2009-2010 school year. The running club is off to a running start, there are between 25-30 runner's. There were some inquiries made about the registration fee for running club, it was clarified that this fee pays for a "healthy" snack and the remainder will go in to the PSA general fund in which will be used for start up fees for the following school year. In the end all of the "profit" from KART will be split 50/50 between the physical education program and the PSA commitment of \$80,000.00 each year.

School Board: Roger reported that the bylaws have been improved. There are seats available, if you would like to nominate yourself or someone else for a three year term, contact Roger. The next meeting is on June 18th, at the rectory or in the school library. All are welcome to attend.
